includes food, beverage, household goods, retail, leisure, cosmetics and luxury goods



Financial Services

includes banks, brokers, payment services, insurance companies, credit card funds and regulators



Professional Services

includes law, accounting, management consultancy and in-house professionals



Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM)

includes health, industries, telecoms, pharmaceuticals, transport and energy

This is awarded to an owner/operator of a business or social enterprise that operates in Britain and may have operations abroad as well. The relevant business must have been operational for a minimum of 18 months prior to 23rd April 2019.

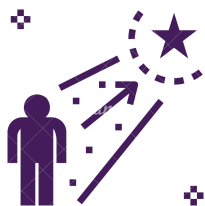


Entrepreneur

Self-Nomination or on behalf of a nominee

- Nominations can be submitted by the nominee themselves or by someone else on behalf of the nominee.
- We encourage self-nominations.

Make a Referral

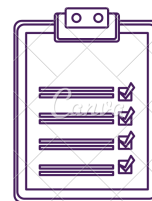
- Anyone can submit a referral using this form.
- Referees are notified of who referred them and will be contacted by the BBBA team to submit a nomination.

Complete the nomination form

- All forms **MUST** be submitted online.
- Takes approximately an hour to complete a high-quality form
- You can submit 3 individual pieces of evidence (one URL equates to one evidence (5MB in total))

Nomination Submitted

- Once you've submitted the form – that's it!
- All nominees will be notified by 12 June if they have been successful.
- Nominees must be available for all the key dates.
- Referees for successful candidates will be contacted to provide a general or financial reference.
